We will establish measurable objectives and targets and report on their progress to ensure our commitment to continuous improvement. We will maintain a safety management system that is regularly evaluated through our auditing processes. We will also audit the working conditions of our service providers to ensure the health and safety of their employees carrying out work on behalf of ANZRP.

We will facilitate transparency in our reporting by openly communicating our health and safety performance, challenges we encounter and achievements we make to our employees, members, service providers and interested stakeholders.
